## On Point Layout (approx. 70" x 70")

## Sashing Fabric: 7/8 Yard

- Cut 36-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Cornerstone Fabric: 1/6 Yard or 1 FQ

- Cut $24-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Side and Corner Triangle Fabric: $11 / 4$ Yards

- Cut 2 - 21 1/8" x 21 1/8" squares. Cut these from corner to corner twice to give you 8 side triangles.
- Cut 2-12 $1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut these from corner to corner once to give you 4 corner triangles.


## Border Fabric: 1 ¼ Yards

- Cut 7 strips 6 " x WOF. Sew pieces end to end to create a long strip. Measure first the sides of your quilt. Cut your strips to size and sew on with a quarter inch. Now
 measure top and bottom of quilt and repeat process.


## Basic Layout (approx. 55" x 70")

## Sashing Fabric: 7/8 Yard

- Cut $31-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Cornerstone Fabric: 1/6 Yard or 1 FQ

- Cut $20-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


## Border Fabric: 1 1/8 Yard

- Cut 6 strips 6" x WOF. Sew pieces end to end to create a long strip.
Measure first the sides of your quilt.
Cut your strips to size and sew on with a quarter inch. Now measure top and bottom of quilt and repeat process.
