## Shades of Blue \& White Floating Point Star Block Challenge

## CUTTING

Medium Fabric
(1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ square - this is the center square of your star

Light Fabric
(4) $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares - these are block corners
(4) $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles - these are background

Dark Fabric
(8) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ squares - these are star points.


SEWING
To make the star points, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each 3" square.
Place one 3 " square on the lower right corner of the $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ "rectangles with right sides together.
Sew along the drawn line. Fold the top half of the $3^{\prime \prime}$ square along the stitching line and press flat. The corners of the $3^{\prime \prime}$ square and the rectangle background should match. Open up the fold and trim off the lower 2 layers leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.

Place the second 3 " square on to the lower left corner of the rectangle unit. Stitch along the drawn line. Fold the top half, press, and trim as you did with the right side square. The finished rectangle unit should now measure $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ ".
